Freja eID Release Notes

These Release Notes describe all the changes made to the Freja eID systems from the previous release. They include:

- changes in the Freja eID mobile application from version 1.4.0 to 2.0.0 (on the Android platform we also had a fix version of the mobile application - 1.4.1 - which included some minor adjustments that had to be made before the release of the version 2.0.0)

ID Protection – a new service for Freja eID+ users

We are happy to announce the launch of a **new, free service available for Freja eID+ users – ID protection**. In addition to having a secure digital identity, Freja eID+ users will now also have the possibility to prevent possible ID theft and protect themselves from fraud.

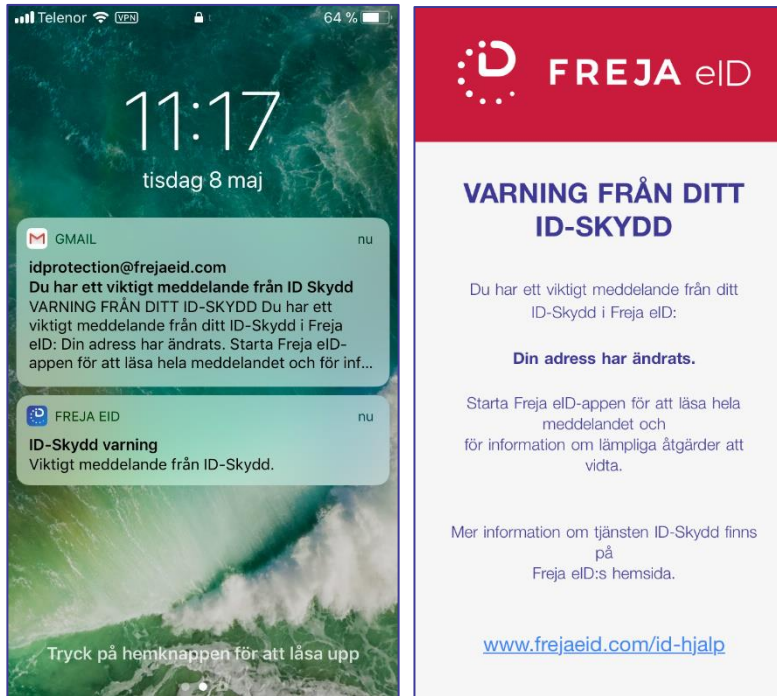
Every year, 200,000 Swedes suffer from ID hijacking or ID theft. An ID hijacking often begins with the fraudster making a change of the victim's address, which is unfortunately quite simple. All the mail of the victim then comes to the fraudster, who can then order things and borrow money in their name.

ID Protection service alerts the user about changes of their official residential address (*folkbokföringsadress*) or special postal address (*särskild postadress*). Upon any change, the user is notified via the app and by email, which gives them the opportunity to act quickly if someone unauthorised has altered their address.

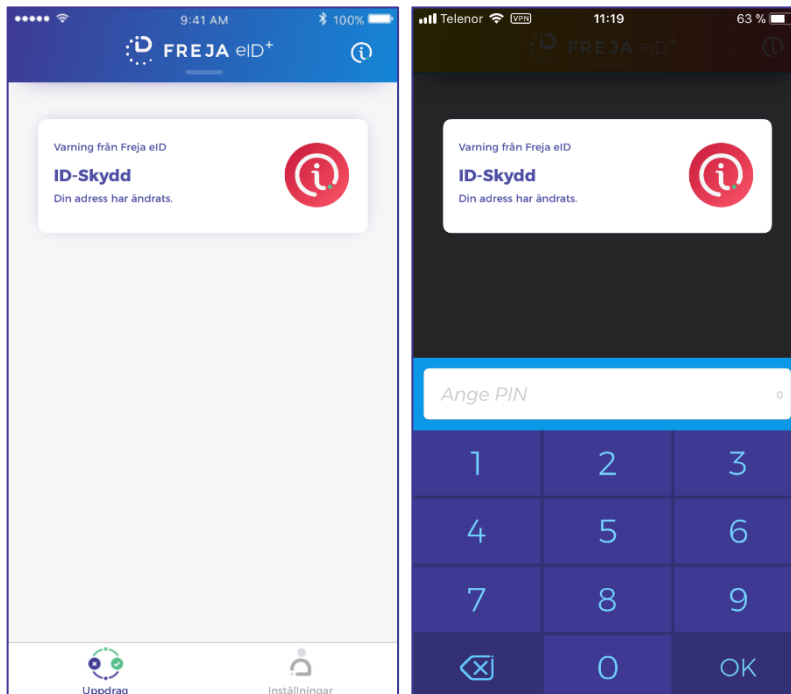
Procedure

The service includes daily surveillance of Freja eID+ users' official residential address and special postal address, via connection with the SPAR database (The National Register of Personal Addresses).

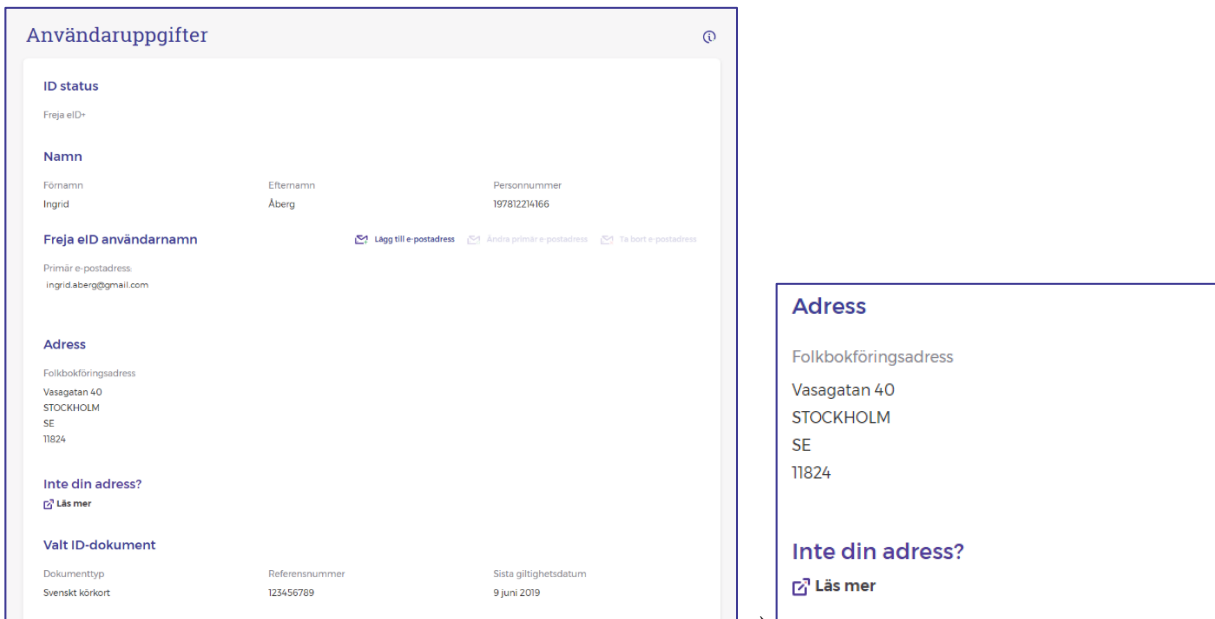
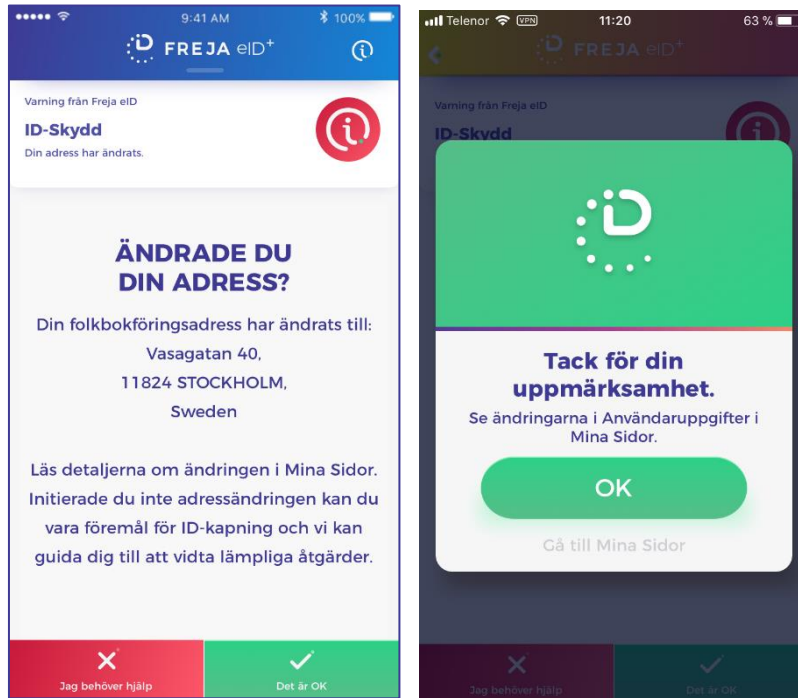
The SPAR database is updated each weekday with the information from the Swedish Tax Agency's Public Register (*Skatteverkets Folkbokföringsregister*). Freja eID+ users' data is checked against the SPAR database after each update. If something has changed from the last update, the user receives a notification about this via email and in the Freja eID mobile app (soon users who register their mobile phone number as Freja eID username will receive an SMS notification about the change as well).



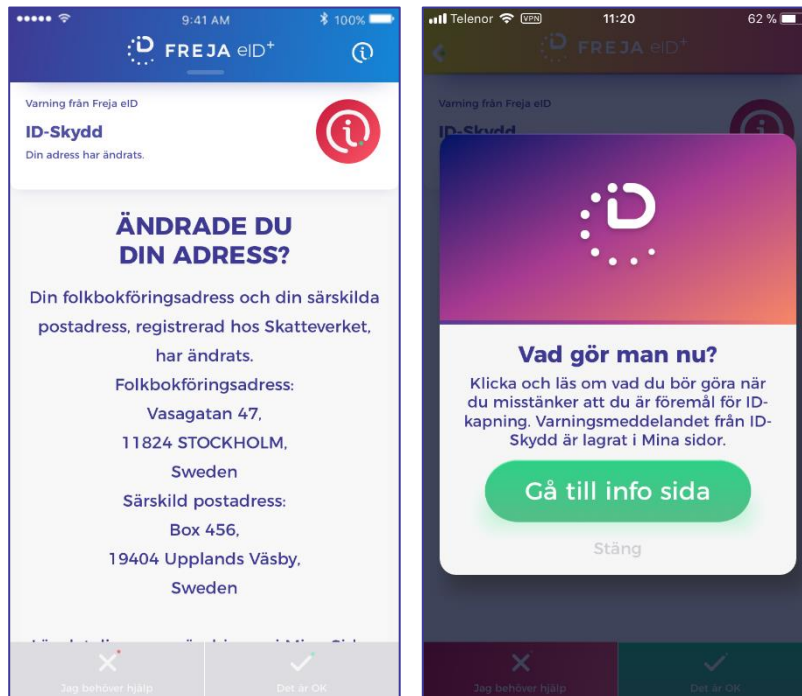
When the notification arrives in the Freja eID mobile app, the user is requested to enter PIN or fingerprint before being able to read the whole message. This adds an additional layer of security, since the message contains the name of the changed address(es), and ensures that only the owner of the Freja ID account can read the notification.



Once the user has read the full content of the ID protection alert, they can confirm that everything is OK – if the user is the one who performed the address change - and are directed to check that the change has been acknowledged in their Freja eID account in My Pages.

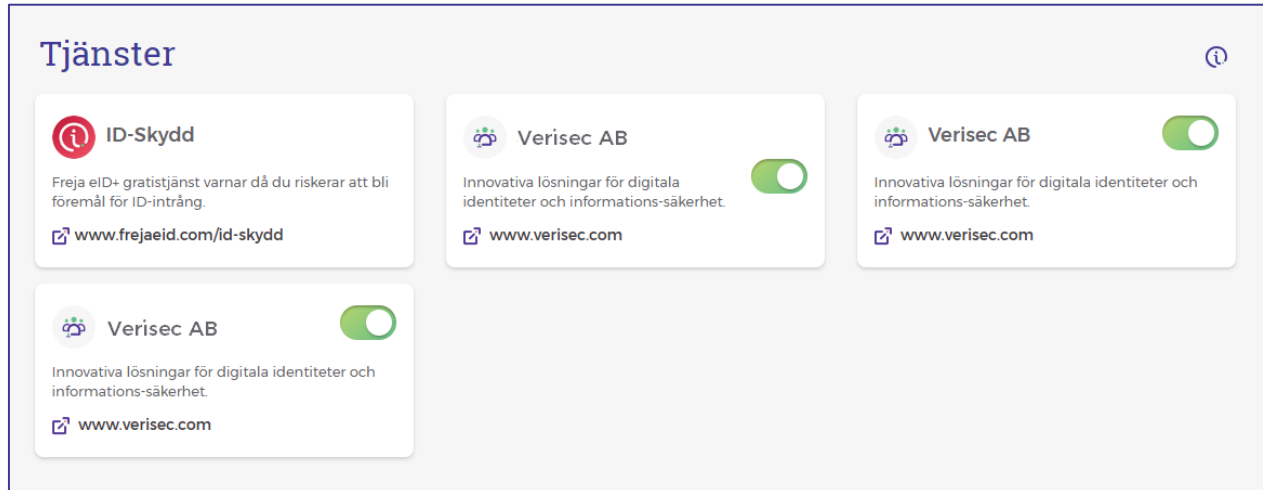


Otherwise, the user can get additional information and guidance on which actions to take next to prevent the fraudster from doing even more damage. The message from the app is safely stored in Action history in My pages, so the user can return to it at any time.
